in 1977 star wars blazed across the screen to become one of the highest grossing and most beloved movies of all time spawning an unprecedented merchandising phenomenon it was followed by two sequels and three prequels all of which became blockbusters comic books novels graphic novels and magazines devoted to the films added to the mythology of george lucas's creation despite the impact of the franchise on popular culture however discussion of the films from a scholarly perspective has not kept pace with the films in sex politics and religion in star wars an anthology douglas brode and leah deyneka have assembled a provocative collection of essays exploring some of the more intriguing aspects of the star wars phenomenon contributors to the volume tackle such hot topics as race and racism in the star wars galaxy judeo christian and eastern religious themes homosexual romance and philosophical and political
